

Homework 3 – Two wrongly placed words.

In this exercise you need to read each sentence and find the two words which are in the wrong place. Underline the two words which should exchange places and the sentence should then make sense.

Helpful hints:

Read the sentence at normal speed. Find the first word which has been misplaced underline it. Then think about where it should go – this should direct you to the second word. Underline this one also. Now read the sentence a final time with the words in the correct order. If it makes sense, move on; if not then try again.

Example: Many chocolates like eating people.

Clearly chocolates do not eat people. These two words should be exchanged to read:

Many people like eating chocolates.

So in this case the two words which should be underlined are people and chocolates

Now look at the next page. Try to do each one as quickly as you can but make sure you finish them all. Time yourself. You need to be able to complete 20 in 10 minutes. When you have finished write your time in the box at the top.
