

Lesson 10 – Finding the Anagrams from Clues.

In this exercise, you need to read the clue and then unscramble the letters on the left hand side to create a word which solves the clue. Write the answer on the line provided.

Helpful hints:

1. First read the clue and try to think of possible answers.
2. Look at the letters and see if any are in the possible answers you have.
3. Beware of double meanings. Some clues may have two possible meanings. If your first thoughts don't appear to work, try to see if the clue could mean something else.

Example:

Mau quira a place where fish swim aquarium

In this case the correct answer would be *aquarium* since this is a place where fish swim. All the answers in this exercise are one word even if the anagram is split up.

Now look at the next page. Try to do each one as quickly as you can but make sure you finish them all. Time yourself. You need to be able to complete 20 in 10 minutes. When you have finished write your time in the box at the top.
