

## Using Adjectives

We use adjectives to describe nouns. Often they are used as pre-modifiers. This means they are placed directly before the noun they qualify. For example, The enormous tree, where 'enormous' describes the tree. Sometimes we use them with the verb 'to be'. For example: The tree is enormous. 'Enormous' still describes the tree. We can use more than one adjective to describe a noun too. For example: the enormous, purple tree.
